The Problem

- Hiking is a healthy outdoor activity, but trails not always clearly marked or maintained
- New trails are not always easy to find
 - Platform will also allow users to discover new trails they may not have known about before
- Goal is to provide information about trails and allow users to provide reviews and information about trail conditions

Four main types of users

- Already active on trails wants to help the community
- Wants to get more out of the experience when walking a trail
- New user of a particular trail concerned about safety
- User who thought walking on trails was too boring, but was encouraged by the points of interest from the map.

- Geographically very diverse, but fewer users in cities

Latents:

- Wildlife Management Area officials

Apathetics:

- City-dwellers
- Those who currently are not active on trails
- Older people who don't use the internet or applications to plan hikes

Defenders:


- Health insurance providers

How often do you go on hikes or walks off of paved sidewalks?



Persona



Since Leah is new to hiking, however, she wants to use commonly used trails in her area with set routes. Further, Leah does not have a regular routine so she may like to go on different routes of different lengths each time. Ideally, Leah needs a system that will safely and consistently guide her through hiking routes in her area.

- Example: Google Maps, Avenza, Gaia GPS















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- There is a demand for an application with more up-to-date trail information and conditions
